



NOBIS Awards 2017

In the frame of the 2nd NOBIS Young Researchers' Day, NOBIS Austria will confer the **NOBIS Awards 2017** for excellent research in the field of biological systematics. They are dedicated to young members of the scientific community. For the first time, two awards, one for master and one for PhD students' talks, will be conferred, each with 300.- Euro and a three years NOBIS membership. These awards are prizes for just completed or nearly finished scientific projects.

Applicants should send their applications as an abstract together with a short scientific curriculum (one page) and the most important own publications and/or research activities to dominique.zimmermann@nhm-wien.ac.at. Please, use the abstract form on our homepage www.nobis-austria.at and provide the following details in your E-mail: Master/PhD student; Talk/Poster.

Among the applicants the candidates are selected by the NOBIS Board and the Advisory Board. Candidates will be invited to present their results at the NOBIS Young Researchers' Day 2017 (1st December 2017; Department of Botany and Biodiversity Research, University of Vienna), and a jury will select the winner during the meeting. Additionally, the best poster will be elected by public vote and awarded with a three years NOBIS membership. The evaluation will be based on scientific significance as well as on the quality of the presentation.

NOBIS membership is required at the time of submission.

Deadline for abstract submission: 15th October 2017
