



NOBIS Awards 2019

In the frame of the 13th annual meeting, NOBIS Austria will confer the **NOBIS Awards 2019** for excellent research in the field of biological systematics. They are dedicated to young members of the scientific community. Two awards, one for master and one for PhD students' talks, will be conferred, each with 500.- Euro and a three years NOBIS membership. These awards are prizes for just completed (< than 1 year ago) or nearly finished scientific projects.

Applicants should send their applications as an abstract together with a short scientific curriculum (one page) and the most important own publications and/or research activities to dominique.zimmermann@nhm-wien.ac.at. Please, use the abstract form on our homepage www.nobis-austria.at and indicate in your E-mail if you apply for the Master or PhD prize.

Among the applicants the candidates are selected by the NOBIS Board and the Advisory Board. Candidates will be invited to present their results at the 13th annual meeting of NOBIS Austria (29th November 2019; Haus der Natur, Salzburg), and a jury will select the winner during the meeting.

Additionally, the best poster will be elected by public vote and awarded with a three years NOBIS membership.

The evaluation will be based on scientific significance as well as on the quality of the presentation.

NOBIS membership is required at the time of submission.
